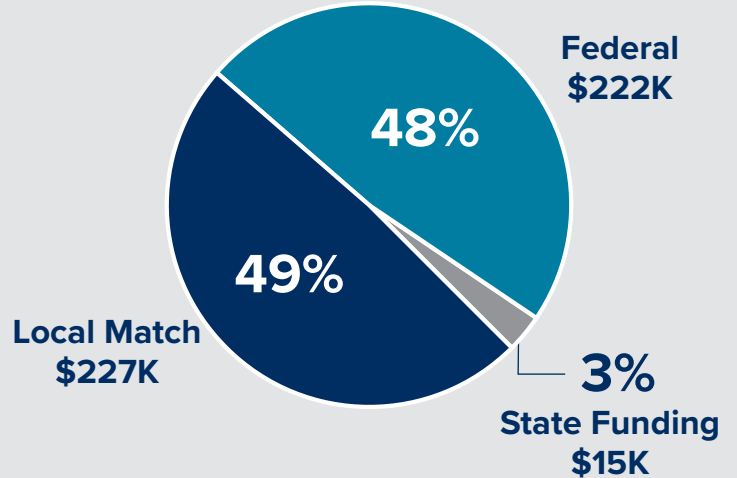


Partners in Success
