



CareerForceMN.com Name Split



- Names of 70,000 users split to align with new format
- Created new fields that align with other DEED systems (Workforce One & MinnesotaWorks.net)
- Prioritized inclusivity when developing naming fields



- Developing process for quality assurance of translations provided by ETO








CareerForceMN.com Sprint Review

What is a sprint review?

- A demonstration of the work that the product team has completed over a specific period
 - This can include new features, bug fixes, and changes to how the product (in this case, CareerForceMN.com) functions
- A time to ask questions and give feedback to the product team





What we accomplished

- ✓ Prepared the data for the name split to use separate name fields (First Name, Middle Initial, Last Name, and Preferred Name):
 - ✓ Conducted data analysis to identify patterns and establish rules to be used for parsing, where possible
 - ✓ Created and refined macros, conducted manual review, conducted committee review, created and refined SQL scripts, tested name split to ensure the parsing and rules were working as expected
 - ✓ Delivered a single encrypted CSV file with the information needed for the name split
 - ✓ Cordinated with PWW to plan and test the name split on the site's lower environments (SANDBOX, QA, and STAGE) ahead of PRODUCTION deploy
- ✓ Prepared the site to import and update user data for the name split to use separate name fields (First Name, Middle Initial, Last Name, and Preferred Name):
 - ✓ Provided MS SQL script(s) to create tables and import data separately
 - ✓ Installed and configured Feeds module for mass updates
 - √ Completed mass action update using the Feeds module and the CSV file provided on the site's lower environments (SANDBOX, QA, and STAGE) ahead of PRODUCTION deploy

- ✓ Prepared the site to use separate name field tokens (First Name, Middle Initial, Last Name, and Preferred Name):
 - √ Welcome to CareerForce modal for new users.
 - ✓ Emails that users receive when they create an account
 - ✓ Emails that employers and DEED staff receive during the employer vetting process
 - ✓ Online forms, including Minnesota Veterans Questionnaire, TAA Contact for career seekers and employers, and Employer Profile Questionnaire
 - ✓ Views, lists, tables, and reports used by admin staff
 - √ Chatbot
- ✓ Deployed and implemented the name split using the new separate name fields to CareerForceMN.com



What we accomplished, continued

- ✓ Fixed Decision Tree errors affecting multiple sections of the site
- ✓ Updated the mobile-responsive site menu to be collapsed by default
- ✓ Created CareerForceMN.com Data Access Request Form
- ✓ Moved the "Save and Continue" button to the center on Welcome to CareerForce modal
- ✓ Removed hyperlink text on the Site Under Maintenance page
- √ Updated User List used by admins to make full usernames visible
- ✓ Investigated Group Announcements issue
- ✓ Investigated ways to increase site speed



Content updates

- Sprint release notes are now available on CareerForceMN.com
- CareerForceMN.com/jobquality page has been updated to align linked resources with "Job Quality Milemarkers on the Road to Good Jobs" handout
- Continuing to simplify and reduce content throughout the site
 - Ex: Linking to DEED's website for various layoff resources instead of duplicating the content on CareerForceMN.com

CareerForceMN.com Release Notes


The CareerForceMN.com team makes regular improvements to the site to improve the customer experience. We document these changes in the release notes below, and we share more detailed demonstrations of updates at the regular product updates/sprint demos.

Sprint 108: 3/27/2024-4/30/2024

Summary: The split of the "First and Last Name" field on user accounts to separate "First Name," "Middle Initial," "Last Name," and "Preferred Name" fields was implemented. Multiple sections of the site were prepared to display the new separate fields, and the back end of the site was prepared for the import of user data with the new separate fields. Improvements were made to multiple features of the site to improve user-friendliness for customers and site admins. An online form was created to allow staff to request additional data access as needed, and methods of increasing the website speed were investigated.

End user changes:

- 1. MNDEED-7478: Updated mobile-responsive hamburger menu to default to Collapsed
 - To improve the experience of users navigating CareerForceMN.com on mobile, we updated the main navigation menu to be collapsed by default, with users able to expand each menu topic as desired.
- 2. MNDEED-7541: Fixed error when selecting a Decision Tree topic

- CareerForceMN.com data request form








Next steps

Highlights for next sprint

- Prompting users to verify the name split and confirm their names are displaying correctly on their profile
- Implementing recommendations to improve and optimize site performance (site speed)
- Updating Job Fairs calendar increased font size, updated design
- Finalizing the service and activity tracking data needed from CareerForceMN.com for Federal, State, and Local reporting
