## **Updates**

• The BEAD Challenge window closes **August 21** – don't wait until the last day in the event your Challenge is rejected as incomplete as you won't have any time to fix it

Reminder on speed tests. Residents and businesses should only do speed tests in the BEAD Challenge Portal if their location shows as SERVED and they subscribe to service of at least 100Mbps download and 20Mbps upload and do not get those speeds when they do a speed test. The speed tests are then used to challenge your location as erroneously being listed as served. If your location already shows as unserved, there is no reason to do a speed test as there is nothing to challenge. Valid speed tests will then be submitted as BEAD Challenges by the non-profit Connected Nation. (Under NTIA requirements, only providers, non-profits, local and Tribal governments are eligible to submit BEAD Challenges.)


