



FEDERAL INCENTIVES

- **U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Grants (HHS):** HHS is the largest grant-making agency in the US. Most HHS grants are provided directly to states, territories, tribes, and educational and community organizations, then given to people and organizations who are eligible to receive funding.
 - Small businesses: For-profit entities that are focused on healthcare, such as small clinics, medical device manufacturers, or healthcare technology startups, may also be eligible for DHHS grants. These entities must have a clear and direct impact on improving healthcare outcomes.
 - Researchers: Researchers who are focused on health-related projects, such as developing new treatments for diseases or studying the effectiveness of healthcare interventions, may also be eligible for DHHS grants.

National Institute of Health: Blueprint MedTech: Program: The mission of the program is to catalyze the translation of novel technologies from early-stage development to readiness for first-in-human clinical studies. The program will provide: (a) non-dilutive funds to support medical device development activities led by investigators, and (b) additional resources and support services including, but not limited to:

- Planning resources to support concept development, team building, needs assessment, and other early translational activities.
- Streamlined access to translational services and expertise
- Assistance from consultants and advice from industry experts (e.g. meetings with an external oversight committee).



Other federal funding incentives include the Small Business Administration (SBA), Americas Seed Fund - Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) and Small Business Technology Transfer (STTR), Food & U.S Department of Commerce | International Trade Administration | SelectUSA Drug Administration - and more!

Prominent Companies in Minnesota

Many Minnesota-Based Companies are Recognized Worldwide

- Minnesota is home to 17 companies on the Fortune 500 list of largest publicly traded firms in the United States and the Minneapolis/ St. Paul metro area ranks #1 in Fortune 500 companies per capita (2024).
- Several Minnesota companies make the Forbes list of largest privately-held companies, including Cargill, one of the world's largest multinationals with operations in 67 countries.

















































Ties Between Germany & Minnesota

- Germany had the second-highest level of investment and second-highest level of employment, by parent country, in Minnesota. (U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis)
- More than 40 companies based in Germany operate about 80 business locations in Minnesota.
- Germany is a top investor in Minnesota: Companies based in Germany operating in Minnesota employed 22,800 people in Minnesota and had \$3.3 billion in investments in gross plant, property and equipment in 2021.
- More than 40 Minnesotan companies operate at about 130 business locations in Germany.
- Germany maintains a diplomatic presence in Minnesota, with an Honorary Consulate based in Shoreview that is headed by Honorary Consul Barbara Müller.

Faster to Market

- FDA 510K clearances are 26% faster than the U.S. average a 30-day advantage.
- Minnesota is the leader in FDA PMAs averaging 6.5 months faster than the U.S. as a whole





Medical Alley = The Most Innovative Medical Device Cluster

- In the last 5 years, Minnesota ranks 3rd in the total number of 510k clearances behind California and Florida.
- However, it ranks 1st by a wide margin in 510k clearances per capita.
- Minnesota ranks 1st in PMAs since 2018.
- 510k clearances are 26% faster than in the rest of the country, PMA approvals are 6.5 months faster
- Cardiovascular, neurology, gastroenterology, urology, and surgery are areas where Minnesota is particularly strong.



Keeping the Costs Down

Compared to other medtech hubs, running a business in Minnesota helps keep the costs down for both employers, and employees.

Cost of living, office space, and cost of housing are all significantly lower compared to Boston, Chicago, New York, and San Francisco.
