BEAD Challenge Timeline






Updates

- OBD recommends eligible rebutters submit their rebuttals as soon as possible, and not wait until the due date, so that if rejected you have time to correct your rebuttal. Rebuttals are due 30 days after notification that a Challenge was received, and the Rebuttal window ends approximately September 20, but you will have a full 30 days to rebut from the date of notification of a Challenge.
- The BEAD FAQ was updated for the rebuttal process on Friday 8/30 it can be viewed on the website, or downloaded as a PDF
- OBD acknowledges that that system had an issue with ISPs not being notified of Challenges for Rebuttal, for those taking speed tests to take 2nd and 3rd speed tests, and calculating rebuttal locations for ISPs with bulk challenges. All have been addressed. Rebuttals will be provided the full 30 days from notification of a Challenge to respond.
